IOWA'S ANNUAL SALES TAX HOLIDAY

**Friday, August 5 and
Saturday, August 6, 2016**

From 12:01 a.m. August 5, 2016 through midnight, August 6, 2016 no sales tax will be collected on sales of clothing and footwear for articles costing \$100 or less in the state of Iowa. NPHA recently added income deductions for child care and excessive work and/or school travel. If your family has out of pocket expenses for child care in order to be gainfully employed, and don't receive any kind of assistance in receiving these services, you may be eligible to have your monthly rent reduced. If you travel more than 60 miles round trip in a day for work and/or school, and don't get paid based on miles traveled, you may also be eligible for a rent reduction. August Maintenance Tips

- ❖ Change your furnace/AC filter
- ❖ Clean Bathroom Vent Fan & Cover
 - Remove the cover, vacuum dust from inside the fan box and wipe blades
 - Use a brush to remove dust from cover then scrub it in soapy water
 - Replace vent fan cover
- ❖ Clean Range Hood Filter and Fan
 - Remove filter and soak in hot, soapy water and use a brush to clean out all grease; or run it through a dishwasher
- ❖ Thoroughly Clean Microwave Inside and Out
- ❖ Clean Oven
 - Use non-toxic, citris oven cleaner and follow label directions
 - Try not to use the oven during the summer so your airconditioner doesn't have to work as hard
- ❖ Clean out Refrigerator and freezer.
 - Wipe down outside and inside with damp cloth
 - Clean all drawers and shelves with hot, soapy water
- ❖ Wash windows, doors and handles, and wipe down all light switches
