FOLLOWING ARE KEY MESSAGES BEHIND THIS YEAR'S "FIRE WON'T WAIT.
PLAN YOUR ESCAPE" THEME:

MAKE SURE YOUR HOME ESCAPE PLAN MEETS THE NEEDS OF ALL YOUR FAMILY MEMBERS, INCLUDING THOSE WITH SENSORY OR PHYSICAL DISABILITIES.

SMOKE ALARMS SHOULD BE INSTALLED INSIDE EVERY SLEEPING ROOM, OUTSIDE EACH SEPARATE SLEEPING AREA, AND ON EVERY LEVEL OF YOUR HOME. SMOKE ALARMS SHOULD BE INTERCONNECTED SO WHEN ONE SOUNDS, THEY ALL SOUND.

KNOW AT LEAST TWO WAYS OUT OF EVERY ROOM, IF POSSIBLE.
MAKE SURE ALL DOORS AND WINDOWS OPEN EASILY.

HAVE AN OUTSIDE MEETING PLACE A SAFE DISTANCE FROM YOUR HOME WHERE EVERYONE SHOULD MEET.

PRACTICE YOUR HOME FIRE DRILL AT LEAST TWICE A YEAR WITH EVERYONE IN THE HOUSEHOLD, INCLUDING GUESTS. PRACTICE AT LEAST ONCE DURING THE DAY AND AT NIGHT.

Never plug your space heaters into extension cords!!!! Please avoid using space heaters if at all possible.

FROM MEDICAL AND DENTAL PROVIDERS TO MENTAL HEALTH PRACTITIONERS, TO HOUSING ASSISTANCE PROGRAMS, OUR GOAL IS TO HELP INDIVIDUALS GET THE RESOURCES AND SERVICES NECESSARY TO BUILD THEIR LIFE AGAIN AND MOVE IN A POSITIVE DIRECTION.

PROJECT HOMELESS CONNECT NORFOLK WILL BE HELD ON FRIDAY, OCTOBER 7TH, 2022 AT OUR SAVIOR LUTHERAN CHURCH IN NORFOLK, NE. THE EVENT WILL TAKE PLACE FROM 10:00AM-3:00PM AND THE CHURCH IS LOCATED AT 2420 W. OMAHA AVE. EVERYBODY IS WELCOME TO ATTEND, ALTHOUGH INDIVIDUALS 18 AND UNDER WILL NEED TO BRING THEIR PARENT OR GUARDIAN WITH THEM IN ORDER TO RECEIVE SERVICES. THERE ARE NO INCOME GUIDELINES AND ALL SERVICES ARE FREE, BUT IT IS A FIRST-COME, FIRST-SERVED EVENT. PLEASE BE PREPARED TO WAIT IN LINE OUTSIDE, AS WE ANTICIPATE A LARGE CROWD.

EACH INDIVIDUAL ENTERING PROJECT HOMELESS
CONNECT NORFOLK WILL BE ASSIGNED A NAVIGATOR, A
TRAINED VOLUNTEER THAT WILL TAKE THEM THROUGH
THE ENTIRE EVENT. FOR THE SAFETY OF EVERYBODY,
INDIVIDUALS WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO GO THROUGH
ANY OF THE EVENT UNATTENDED. IDENTIFICATION IS
NOT REQUIRED, BUT INDIVIDUALS WHO WISH TO ENTER
PROJECT HOMELESS CONNECT NORFOLK MUST
REGISTER THEIR INFORMATION BEFORE ENTERING THE
EVENT. THIS WILL HELP OUR STEERING COMMITTEES
PLAN FOR NEXT YEAR'S EVENT.
