Free Income Tax Preparation Services:

Low-income individuals/families and senior citizens (60 & over) benefit from this area wide tax program. Family Service Coordinators are trained to help prepare tax forms and/or answer tax questions. All offices are equipped to e-file. Coordinators also assist with Homestead Exemption preparation. No self-employed or farm returns are prepared. Winter Safety Tips for Homeowners & Renters

- ▲ Keep a steady drip. Maintain a continuous drip of water from one faucet in your home, preferably a sink farthest from where the water comes into the house.
- Open your cabinets. Keep cabinet doors open under sinks.
- Insulate your pipes. Use heat tape, foam, or rubber
- insulation to protect your pipes.
 - Outdoor faucets. Cover hose bibs with hose bib cover.
- ✓ Clean your chimney at least once a year.
- ▲ Always use a fireplace screen.
- ✓ Use a metal container for ashes and make sure ashes are cool before putting them in container.
- ✓ Follow the 3-Foot Rule. Avoid placing a space heater within 3 feet of anything flammable; curtains, papers, furniture, etc.).
- Do not leave your space heater unattended.
- Plug your space heater into a wall outlet.
 Do not use an extension cord!
